Throughout the year we will also have a programme of volunteer days on which we ask volunteers to help us with a variety of out-door jobs in the woods, orchard and garden. We hope to make the work on these days varied and interesting and invite families with children. We will provide a hearty soup for lunch. Once they are arranged these dates will be added to the programme, and will be advertised through our contact list.

Who we are:

The Monimail Tower Project is a small environmental charity that offers opportunities in environmental and horticultural education; carries out organic gardening and woodland work with volunteers; maintains the historic buildings and walls on the property; and models a sustainable lifestyle. There is a small group of residents, four acres of walled gardens, 12 acres of woodland and a renovated 15th- or 16th-century tower, once part of a summer palace that was used by the ancient bishops of St. Andrews.

Directions:

By bus: There are buses from Dundee/Glenrothes to Letham road end and it is then a 10 minute walk through Letham village and on to Monimail. There are also buses from Cupar to Letham village.

By train: Ladybank station is approximately three miles from Monimail.

By car: Turn off the A92 to Letham village (west of Cupar) and follow the road through Letham.

When you reach Monimail village, coming from Letham, turn into the first driveway on the left, and then turn right into the car park for Monimail Tower. The main house is through the gate on your left, and then left again, up through the garden.
